The following are the taxa or plumage forms of bird species which are presently in the Sri Lanka List or its two Appendices and of which any report needs to be evaluated by the CBCRRC. Each is either a rare or/and 'confusion' species or subspecies or a plumage form which can be difficult to identify. The CBC requests that if an observation is made of any of these a report be submitted to the CBCRRC according to the format in the Rarity Report Form, so that it will be properly included in ornithological records if ratified.
